

NAME

gf2pbm – convert a character from a GF font file to PBM format

SYNOPSIS

gf2pbm [*options*] *GF-file*

DESCRIPTION

This manual page documents briefly the **gf2pbm** command. **gf2pbm** is a program that converts a single character from a METAFONT-produced GF font file to PBM format. It is used internally by **mftrace**(1) to feed to **autotrace**(1) to create a Postscript outline description of the character.

OPTIONS

- b** Dump a bitmap file.
- s** Show glyph size.
- n** *NUM*
 Process glyph number *NUM*.
- o** *FILE*
 Output to *FILE* instead of *stdout*.
- h** Show summary of options.
- d** Display debugging information.

EXIT STATUS

gf2pbm exits with status 0 if successful, status 1 if the requested glyph did not exist and status 2 if there was some other error.
